Adult Outdoor Gym Equipment

Opal and Southern Flinders LIFE initiative in conjunction with DCMR will contribute funding for Adult Exercise Equipment. Progress Association will contribute up to \$5,000. The project aims to increase opportunities for physical activity and encourage healthy lifestyle for local residents. The site will be next to the playground on the Esplanade. Project will commence soon.



Upgrade of the Beach Front

The upgrade of the Beach Front is due to commence at the end of the year.

Beach Shed

2 new plastic blinds have been ordered for the Beach Shed and should be ready soon.

Underground Gas/Water at Caravan Park

With the help of Volunteers and McCoomb Plumbing & Gas the Caravan Park now has LPG gas underground. A new LPG container called the Bullet has been installed and the price of the LPG gas is now at a cheaper rate than the Bottle price. At the same time as the trench was open for the gas line the water pipe has been upgraded throughout the park and drawings of the park showing underground pipes, storm water, septic and electrical is being prepared for further reference.



Institute Hall

Night Sensor lights has been initiated by Progress and another light on the eastern side at the Exit is to be installed. There will always be light now when entering the Hall at night time.

Slashing of grass around Town

Council has been busy during October slashing roadside grass growth. The entrance into High Street looks great.



New Gas Crab Cooker and Upgraded Crab House

The Crab House has been extended and a new gas cooker has been purchased and 2 large steel containers with lids purchased for crab cooking. This is now connected to the underground gas line. Crab cooking is now a more safer environment for everyone to use.



Tree Lopping in the Caravan Park

During September Mid North Tree & Stump Removals were called in to trim all the trees within the Caravan Park. This is now a much safer environment.
